CONTRACT NO. 3 INDUSTRIAL PARK SITE FENCING

Principal items of work include approximately 4130 feet of 6' high chain link fence and approximately 2100 feet of MDOT standard wire fence.

CONTRACT NO. 4 INDUSTRIAL PARK SITE GASLINE EXTENSION

Principal items of work include: Approximately 9600 feet of 4-inch medium density plastic pipe with related appurtenances.
