This project shall be constructed in accordance with the latest edition of the Mississippi Standard Specifications for State Aid Road and Bridge Construction.

PLANS AND PROPOSALS may be secured from Glenn Pogue, County Engineer for Scott County, Mississippi, 1724b 23rd Avenue, Meridian. The Cost is twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for plans and twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the proposal, non-refundable.

Certified check or bid bond for five percent (5%) of the total bid, made payable to Scott County and the State of Mississippi must accompany each proposal.

Bidders are hereby notified that any proposal accompanied by letters qualifying in any manner the condition under which the proposal is tendered will be considered an irregular bid and such proposal will not be considered in making the award.
